

FAQs Salvat Bach Grant

1. Must I have all the dates available for all concerts programmed by Salvat Beca Bach (SBB)?

Yes. The winners of the SBB must commit to participating in all programmed concerts (see the rules), as well as in the two previous rehearsals.

2. Is there an age limit when presenting an application for the SBB?

Yes. The grant is given to singers from the ages of 18 to 35, and singers must be in the age range before 1 January 2022.

3. What do I have to do to apply for the SBB 2022 call?

An email should be sent to: salvatbecabach@fundacionsalvat.com including all required documentation as set out in the rules.

4. How should the video be sent?

The videos must be uploaded to YouTube or Vimeo, with the link included in the application email. If you do not want the video to be public, you can put it in *Unlisted* mode, but not as a private video accessed by password.

5. Can I send an older video?

No. We ask for a video recorded in the year 2021, and not previously.

6. How should I send in the documentation?

Your professional and artistic bio must be attached to the PDF format application form.

7. What are the application dates?

From 1st September to 10th October 2021.

8. How many phases does the selection process for applicants have?

The selection process includes a previous selection and two in-person phases. The previous selection is the evaluation of each candidate on the basis of the materials

(video, cv) that you have sent to us with the application. The FIRST in-person phase is an audition carried out in Barcelona (Palau de la Música Catalana) and Madrid (Teatro Real). The SECOND phase is the final audition at the Gran Teatre del Liceu in Barcelona.

9. Can I apply to do my audition in Barcelona and Madrid in the same call?

No. It is only possible to apply to do the audition in one of the cities.

10. Can I do the audition online, or in virtual format?

No. Unfortunately, all auditions are done in person and the only candidates considered are those who are able to attend them.

11. Do you pay the costs arising from the auditions?

No. The travel costs for attending auditions are the responsibility of the candidate, regardless of whether the candidate is eventually selected or if no candidate at all is selected for a position.

12. Do I have to bring my own pianist/accompanist to the personal audition?

The audition space has a harpsichord available. The candidates will have an accompanist available, who is able to accompany them on the piano, tuned at 440 Hz. If candidates prefer, they can come to the audition with their own accompanist.

13. What do I have to bring on the day of the auditions?

It is not necessary to bring copies of the work you will sing. Before the audition, you will be required to send the score in digital format, using the edition you will be using.

14. If I have received the Salvat Bach Grant in a previous edition, can I apply again?

No. The SBB is only awarded once per candidate. However, we do consider grant winners from all previous editions when programming the Fundació Salvat's annual productions.
